



DEVELOPMENT UPDATES

After the recent takeover of Telford Homes by Trammell Crow, a subsidiary of CBRE, we are on track to start major works in Crisp Street in the Spring/Summer of 2020. As planned work will start on the north side of the market at Cordelia Street.

The work will take place over two phases, phase one starts on Cordelia Street and works south to the south side of Market Square, once complete phase two will include the south side of Market Square and continue south to East India Dock Road.

Towards the end of Phase one you will see existing businesses moving north, Barclay's Bank, Boots, Iceland, the Post Office, Shoe Zone and of course East-Enders Pie and Mash will all move to permanent new premises

in Market Way or Market Square to join the existing businesses in that area creating a vibrant retail hub that will supply all your daily shopping needs.

Some of the other shops will also be moving around the market, watch this space to see who's moving where and when.

In approximately 18/24 months the Market stalls will temporarily move south to East India Dock Road while we refurbish Market Square with a new canopy, new paving, new trader facilities and improved electricity supply. The Market Square refurbishment is expected to take about 12 months after which all the stalls will return to their new pitches in Market Square.

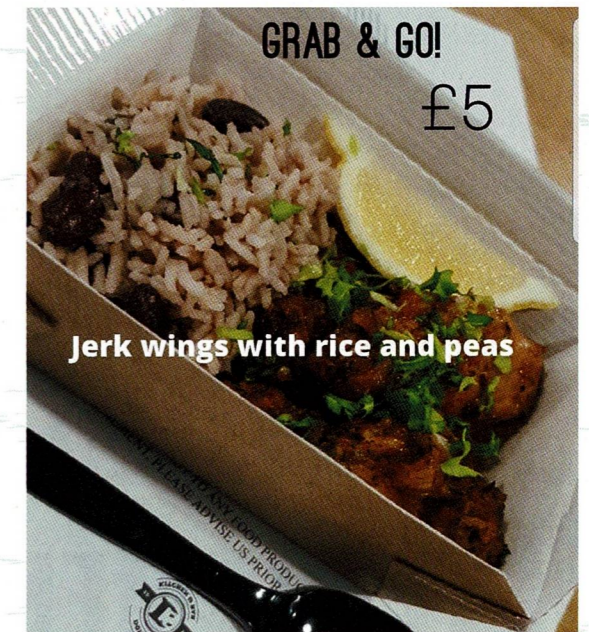
